ELECTOR QUALIFICATION

There is no need to pre-register to vote as the registration of all electors for this election will take place at the time of voting. You will be required to make a declaration that you meet the following requirements:

- 18 years of age or older on general voting day
- Canadian citizen
- resident of BC for at least 6 months immediately preceding the day of registration
- resident of OR registered owner of real property in the Village of Port Alice for at least 30 days immediately preceding the day of registration, and
- not disqualified by the *Local Government Act* or any other enactment from voting in an election or otherwise disqualified by law.

Resident electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature). Picture identification is not necessary. The identification must prove both residency and identity.

Non-resident property electors must produce **2 pieces of identification** (at least one with a signature) to prove identity, **proof** that they are entitled to register in relation to the property, and, if there is more than one owner of the property, **written consent** from the majority of the property owners. Consent forms may be obtained from the Chief Election Officer by calling (250) 284-3391 or at the Village of Port Alice, 1061 Marine Drive during office hours 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday to Friday (excluding statutory holidays).
