The Village of Port Alice is accepting applications for the position of Casual on call Recycling Attendant / Public Works Labourer 1. The Recycling Attendant will be responsible for the operation of the municipal Recycling Depot which is open to the public on Wednesdays and Saturdays. The Labourer will perform any and all duties in connection with the operation of the Public Works Department, including but not limited to, general labour, operation of all public works equipment, maintenance of water/sewer systems, road maintenance, and grounds keeping as directed by the Public Works Foreman.

A valid Class 5 Driver's License is a requirement. Applicants should be physically fit and willing and able to work out of doors in all weather conditions.

Experience in safe excavation practices, backhoe/truck/snowplow/heavy equipment experience, First Aid and confined space entry ticket would be an asset.

This position is within the Collective Bargaining Unit of CUPE Local 401 and the rate of pay will be \$21.84 - \$24.04/hour plus 11.08% for vacation pay and payment in lieu of benefits.
