BYLAW NO.635

A BYLAW TO AMEND THE VILLAGE OF PORT ALICE MARINA BYLAW No. 601, 2013

WHEREAS under the Marina Bylaw No. 601, 2013, the Village of Port Alice enacted the bylaw to regulate the operation of the Marina facility owned and operated by the Village of Port Alice;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Port Alice wishes to amend Marina Bylaw No. 601, 2013 by amend Bylaw No. 601 to add new definitions and regulations.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Port Alice enacts as follows:

1. TITLE

- (a) This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as the "Village of Port Alice Marina Bylaw Amendment Bylaw No. 635

2. Marine Bylaw No. 601, 2013 is hereby amended by the following:

- (a) Section 2 is amended by:
 - i. Deleting the definition "live – aboard" and replacing it with "live-aboard" means any vessel that is occupied overnight at the Marina for more than two consecutive weeks or 14 consecutive or nonconsecutive days within the period of one month and applies to non-Port Alice residence only.
 - ii. Adding the definition "Port Alice Resident" means a person (s) who owns a residence or rents a residence within the Village of Port Alice and surrounding areas,
- (b) Adding Section 4.17 The dumping of sewage or greywater is strictly prohibited.
- (c) Adding Sections 4.32 Noise as a result of partying, the use of foul language and the use of illegal drugs is not permitted on or in the area of the Marina.
- (d) Sections 4.17 through 4.31 are renamed sections 4.17 to 4.33 respectively.

If a court of competent jurisdiction declares any portion of this bylaw invalid, then the invalid portion must be severed and the remainder of the bylaw is deemed valid.
