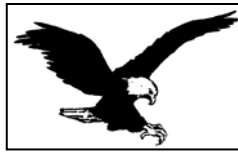

**VILLAGE OF PORT ALICE**  
**SIDEWALK & FOOTBRIDGE WINTER MAINTENANCE POLICY**  
**2011-2012 Winter Season**

During the 2010/2011 winter season, please be aware that the Village of Port Alice does not have the financial means, or the manpower to remove snow and/or ice from the sidewalks in the village.

When the sidewalks and/or footbridges are covered with snow and/or ice they are very slippery. Please use extreme caution when walking on them. Under the policy the Public Works Crew is directed to clear the **footbridges only** after the major roads and streets have been cleared.

Depending on the weather conditions, clearing the sidewalk of snow sometimes makes the situation worse when there is an underlying layer of ice that gets brought to the surface.

We regret this inconvenience brought on by forces of nature, and remind you to use **extreme caution** when using the sidewalks and footbridges during the winter, and that you are doing so at your own risk.

## Winter Driving

As we are aware, winter has come. By all accounts, we will be experiencing a large volume of snow and icy conditions. Within our geographical area, there are numerous mountains, hills and windy roadways to contend with. In winter conditions, traction and stability become important issues. There are a few simple solutions to alleviate problems that you may encounter. Make sure we have good tires. We should also take ten. Take ten seconds. Ten minutes if needed, to arrive safely at our destinations.

Public Works crews will be out on our roadways plowing snow, sanding and salting in order to provide the best possible outcomes and solutions for public safety on our roadways. There are a number of issues that our crews encounter daily that lead to dangerous situations. When you see a sign “Crew and Equipment Working”, and “Prepare to Stop”, this always means that there is something going on ahead. This is the time to take ten. Ten seconds or ten extra minutes to travel through these work zones, so that we are not jeopardizing ourselves and our fellow workers.

Jogging down the road is very healthy. Everyone wants to get in shape, but if you are dressed in black in dark conditions, with no reflective clothing, it is not really that healthy or safe. Our children love to play outside when it snows. **It is a lot of fun.** One of the biggest problems that the snow plow encounters is children tobogganing out in front of the plow in dark conditions. For the driver of that plow, seeing a child come flying across the street on a toboggan right in front of him, scares the heck right out of him. As parents, we not only have an obligation but a duty to make sure that our children are playing safely.

And perhaps the most dangerous of all, passing the snow plow when it is plowing the road to the mill. There is no way you can possibly see around corners. Once again, take ten. Ten seconds or ten minutes to arrive at your destination safely.

Let's all just slow down a bit and enjoy the winter season without regrets. Have a safe and Happy Christmas!

# *Recycling News....*

## **PLASTICS 101**

At the start of recycling, we collected only milk jugs, now we can keep almost all plastics out of the land fill. But not all plastics are created equal. How do you tell if it can be recycled you ask? Well first off, get out your glasses or even a magnifying glass, because you have to hunt down that sometimes small recycle symbol, the triangle with the numbers 1-7 enclosed. If you liked the book "Where's Waldo", you'll love this game. I know it sounds too much like work, but we are creatures of habit, and repeatedly buy the same products, so once you establish the plastic container can be recycled, it's just a simple task to put it aside 'till your next trip down to the municipal yard. You will find the plastic collection site under the covered area just left of the cardboard bin. There we accept:

- RINSED milk jugs with no caps please
- RINSED waxed milk cartons
- EMPTY and RINSED plastic containers marked 1 thru 7 [check out their lids, some do not have the recycle symbol]

CLEAN plastic bags with the recycling symbol marked with 2 or 4 [place in the blue barrel] So start checking out your plastic! Yogurt, cottage cheese, vitamins, margarine, dish & laundry soap, vinegar, cleaning fluids, all examples of plastic containers that can be recycled! Grocery, some bread, produce are examples of plastic bags. Styrofoam meat trays, although marked with the symbol, ARE NOT accepted at this time. Please ensure your items are empty and rinsed, and DO NOT drop off dirty plastic bags, these can not be recycled.

With the onset of the Holidays, we would like to remind you that colorful wrapping paper is not accepted for recycling, too much dye.
