Council Remuneration - Time to Catch Up

After negotiating a new Collective Bargaining Agreement and while working through the 2013 budget process, it came to Council's attention that their remuneration had not been increased since 1994. Currently the Mayor is compensated \$7200 per year for her work as the elected leader of the Village and Councilors are paid \$4800 each per year. Collectively, our Mayor and Council are paid a total of \$26,400 per year which is less than we pay for annual audit. And for this they govern the Village, which is a corporation with an annual operating budget of over \$3,000,000. This seemed a little out of line.

So we did some research and realized that our elected officials are paid considerably less than Mayors and Councilors in similar communities. In fact, when compared to communities with similar operating budgets, our officials came out as the second lowest paid in the Province. Then we surveyed our neighboring jurisdictions and looked at how they were compensating their elected officials. The figures are rounded but they do show quite a difference in remuneration levels.

Communities with an Average Operating Budget of \$3,000,000
Average Remuneration for the Mayor is \$13,000
Average Remuneration for the Councilor is \$7800

What we found overall is that Councils are slow to update their remuneration bylaws and that Council compensation is not regularly reviewed during annual budget discussions. Our Council wants to change that and wants to ensure that future Councils will be compensated for their work and will not have to continuously revisit the issue.

What the Council came up with is a new rate which is more in line with other jurisdictions of our size and budget level and which are incorporated into Remuneration Bylaw No. 596, 2013. In addition, future increases will be tied to the increases employee wages as approved within the Collective Bargaining Agreement.
