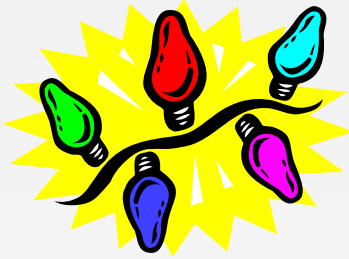

Over the years, this small group of dedicated volunteers have ensured that recycling options have been made available to the public. The first building was erected to cover the glass crusher (no longer in use) and there were wooden boxes for the collection of milk containers and tin cans. The inside depot was open 4 hours a week and manned by volunteers. Boy have we come a long way Baby!! Now we have three employees (one supervisor and two students), who take care of the expanded collection of recycling materials, and the inside depot is open 12 hours a week. Many volunteer hours are added on a weekly basis, to keep up with the sometimes overwhelming collection. Thank you Port Alice for embracing recycling and helping "Mother Earth". History of Port Alice
