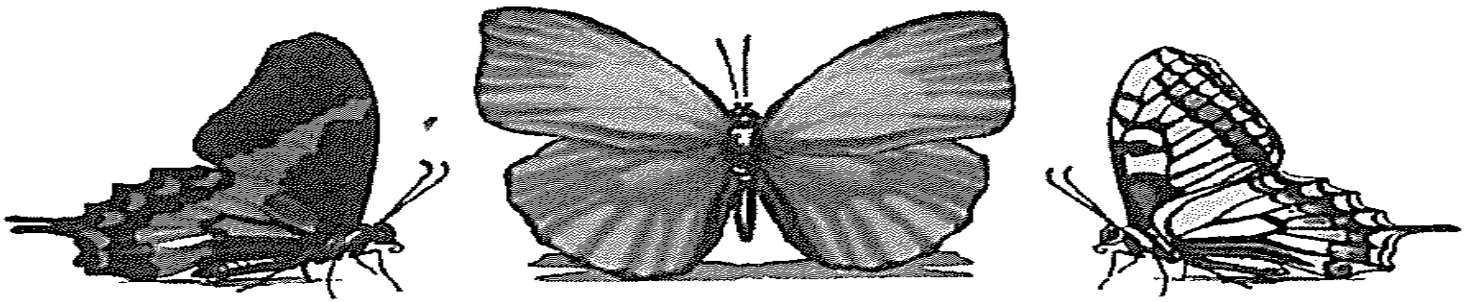

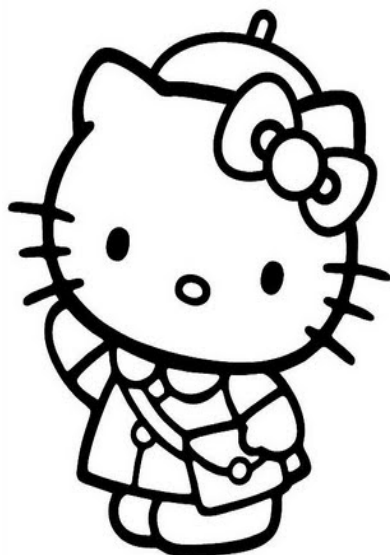

Port Alice Welcomes Const. Darren Regush!

When Const. Darren Regush graduated from Depot in 2006, it was by far the proudest day of his life. Wearing the red sash, he had a sense of pride knowing his parents were there along with the women who inspired him to become a Mountie.

Regush stutters, a handicap which nearly disqualified him from becoming a Mountie. He also came close on three separate occasions to dropping out of Depot, which he describes as the six most grueling months of his life.

Regush was born and raised in Kitimat and worked at Save On Foods and Alcan until he decided to pursue a policing career after his close friend, Laurie White, was shot in the leg while serving a warrant. "Laurie was back to work within 10 months and after what she went through, it was an inspiration for me," he said.

Regush spent four years in auxiliary before landing his first full-time job in Alert Bay.

He moved to Penticton in June 2006 where he met current girlfriend Marnie. They are expecting their first child in February 2012!

"I like helping people and being out in the community. When we do parades, it's nice seeing the kids faces light up," he recalls.

A member of the Penticton Community Safety Team, his favorite part of the job was speaking with school kids. There was a time when the thoughts of granting a newspaper interview or addressing a large group would terrify him.

Instead, he is who he is and often seeks out students with speech impediments hoping to serve as a mentor.

"If I can do it, anybody can" he declares.

His stuttering almost cost him any hope of a job because a Mountie needs to be understood while on radio.

As a child he was always teased and still gets it to this day. Bullying wasn't a problem only because he was physically big and active in sports. The mean words were hurtful but he survived learning how to deal with the adversity at a young age.

Battery Recycling:

- ⇒ The Depot is now accepting **both Alkaline and Rechargeable Batteries** for recycling.
- ⇒ Rechargeable batteries eligible for collection and recycling are: Nickel Cadmium (Ni-Cd), Lithium Ion (Li-ion), Nickel Metal Hydride (Ni-MH) and Small Sealed Lead (Pb).
- ⇒ Small dry cell portable rechargeable batteries are commonly found in cordless power tools, cellular and cordless phones, laptop computers, camcorders, two-way radios and remote control toys. Please help keep the outside depot clean and rodent free. Rinse your milk jugs, plastics and tins and remove any caps.

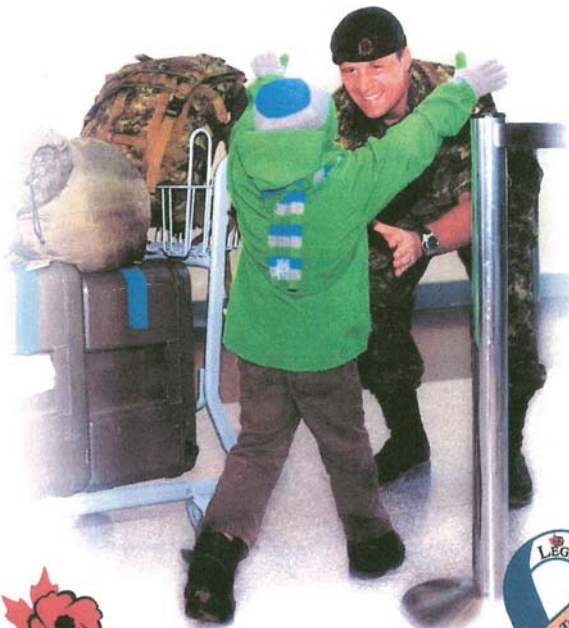

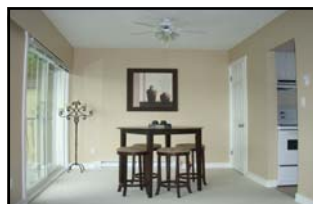

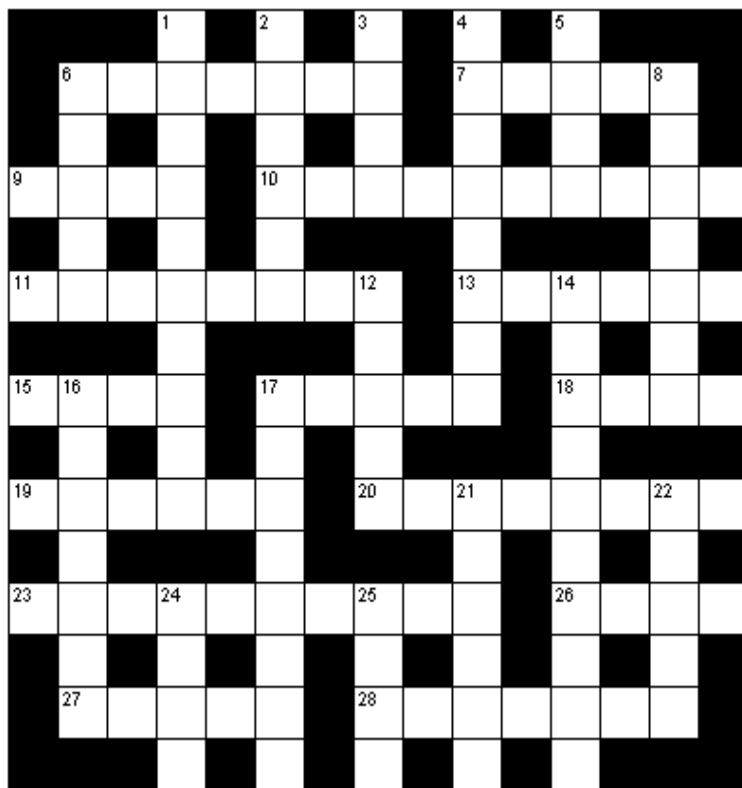
