Municipal Updates

Council Meetings: Due to provincial health regulations put in place by the Provincial Health Office we are unable to allow the public into Council meetings for the time being. Port Alice Website: Phase 1 of the new website went live in December. Currently we have Agendas\Minutes, Bylaws, community notices and Rumble Sheets easily accessible to keep our residents informed. Phase 2 is in progress and set to be complete in March of 2021. We are excited to see the site come together with more security for users.

Rumble Beach Marina: The final work has been completed on the long awaited dock replacement. We are very grateful for the communities patience while we worked through this long process. The system was tested by storms immediately after being installed and we are very happy to report the new docks have withstood this winter season without issue!

Sidewalk & Footbridge Winter Maintenance Policy 2020 - 2021 Winter Season

During the 2020 - 2021 winter season, please be aware that the Village of Port Alice does not remove snow and/or ice from the public sidewalks in the village.

When the sidewalks and/or footbridges are covered with snow and/or ice they are very slippery. Please use extreme caution when walking on them. Under the policy the Public Works Crew is directed to clear the **footbridges only**, and only after the major roads and streets have been cleared.

We regret this inconvenience brought on by forces of nature, and remind you to use **extreme caution** when using the sidewalks and footbridges during the winter, and that you are doing so at your own risk.

TRANSFER STATION NOTICE

The **Transfer Station** will remain open for recycling and garbage disposal during regular operating hours. There will be no bottle collection at this time. **We will only be able to keep the facility open if residents respect the social distancing guidelines while using the service.**

One person in the indoor recycling facility at a time and no scavenging or visiting while on-site. We ask that the public stay out of the Public Works yard and shop area.

Village of Port Alice Wood Stove Exchange Program



The Port Alice Wood Stove Exchange Program is designed to encourage residents to exchange their old, inefficient, non-EPA certified wood burning appliances for new EPA-certified wood burning stoves and inserts, and other qualifying appliances including gas, pellet and electric. (Some exceptions apply).

Port Alice residents who exchange their old wood-burning appliance for one qualified under the Program, are eligible to receive a **\$250 rebate**, providing that the old stove will be decommissioned and recycled.

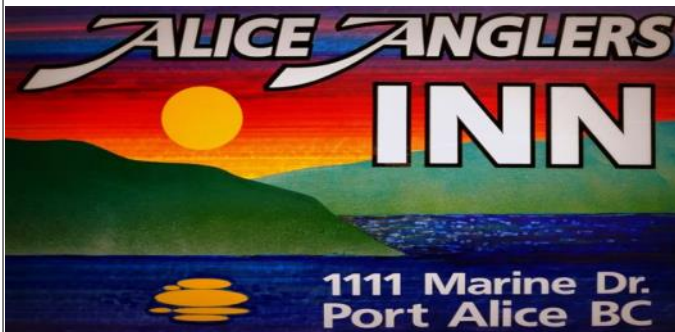
