Spring is here! Remember to be bear aware

Bears come out of hibernation in the spring, but the timing can vary depending on local weather conditions and terrain. For example, some bears on the coast have been spotted roaming during mild winters.

How to avoid attracting hungry bears:

- Keep garbage, recycling and compost inside until pick-up day
- Regularly clean garbage and recycling bins, cover food compost with dry leaves or grass clippings
- Pick up ripe and fallen fruit daily, harvest ripe vegetables
- Clean barbecue grills after every use, store when not in use
- Don't leave pet food outside or use bird feeders April to October

Are all the jobs online and out of reach? Is a lack of computer skills holding you back? Do you want to job search in the modern way? Do you need basic computer skills and don't know where to turn?

A lack of computer skills or "digital literacy" makes modern job search difficult. Most jobs are posted online and many employers expect job applicants to apply through online forms or send a digital resume via email.

In the CONNECT4WORK program learners will start from the basics – turning on a pc, using a mouse, understanding technology vocabulary – and build on their skills over 6 weeks.

On program completion, students will be able to: use a laptop to search for and apply for work, take online classes to upgrade their skills or explore new careers, use a conferencing/learning platform like zoom, communicate effectively through email, become familiar with Word to edit or create a resume and cover letter, and access online services for banking, libraries, health and government services.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to be unemployed to participate? No. If you are looking for a better job or a new job, you can take the program.

Will there be tests? No. The goal is to learn what you need to, to meet your goals at your own pace. Will I earn academic credit? No, but it's a great item to add to your resume!



CONNECT4WORK: Introduction to computers for job seekers is a FREE program that shows you how to use technology to:

- look for work
- access online government, health and other services
- pursue continuing education
- connect to family and community

*We provide a laptop computer to use during the program.

Timing: Class time is 36 hours over 6 weeks. We will work with learners to determine the days and times.

Classes during COVID-19: We hope restrictions will be lifted in April to hold classes of 8 learners with masks and distanced work spaces in the Larry Pepper Room at the Community Centre. We will reschedule or reconfigure as necessary to follow provincial health guidelines.

CONNECT4WORK was created by the Mount Waddington Family Literacy Society to help North Vancouver Island job seekers. This beta-test program is part of a three-year research project that looked at the learning needs of local workers who have been displaced from their jobs by closures, shift cuts, natural disasters or COVID-19. Research included round table discussions with Mount Waddington organizations and businesses, individual surveys, interviews, and a case study.

The Port Alice Wood Stove Exchange Program is designed to encourage residents to exchange their old, inefficient, non-EPA certified wood burning appliances for new EPA-certified wood burning stoves and inserts, and other qualifying appliances including gas, pellet and electric. (Some exceptions apply).

Port Alice residents who exchange their old wood-burning appliance for one qualified under the Program, are eligible to receive a **<u>\$250 rebate</u>**, providing that the old stove will be decommissioned and recycled.




