The Village of Port Alice is looking for one youth worker at the Port Alice Public Works Department, from June 24th to August 30th, 2024.

The duties will include but not necessarily be limited to:

- 1) Grounds keeping such as weed eating, mowing lawns, and other landscaping duties;
- 2) Painting;
- 3) Other related duties

Qualifications

- 1) Worker must be between 15 and 30 years of age.
- 2) Worker must be comfortable learning about and operating weed-eater, lawn mower, and other maintenance equipment.
