This month we have provided a wide range of activities for all ages. We have a new addition for adults with Belly Dance. We appreciate Sheila volunteering her time for this twice a week class. Sheila has done three classes for September and will resume the class on October 15th. In the meantime, one of the participants has offered to teach Bollywood dancing to keep their momentum going. Ladies are happy to have this program going.

There was a Dance Performance on September 5th by the BC Movement Arts. They rented the gym to give a performance of music and interpretive dance. It was attended by about thirty people.
