Volunteer Transportation Network

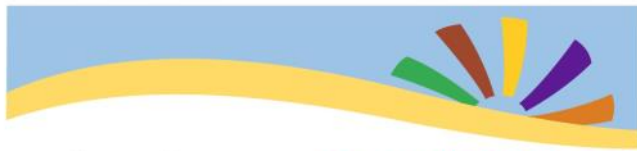


The Volunteer Transportation Network is currently looking for volunteer drivers in Port Alice.

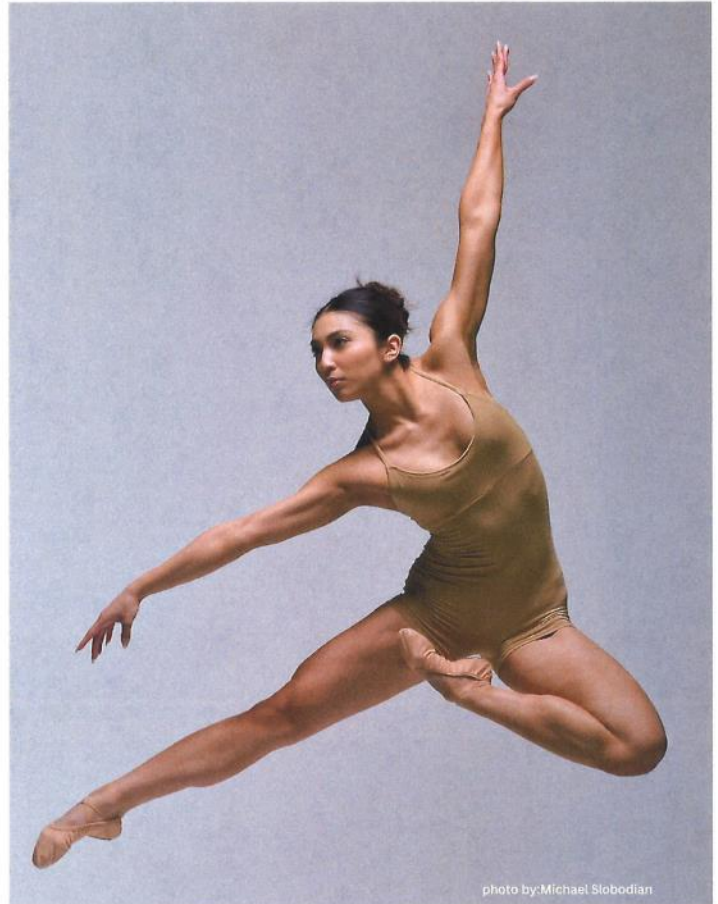

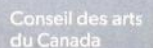
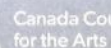
