Subject: April's Month End Report

An adult volunteer has started a Supervised Teen Weight Room a couple days a week. The volunteer did the necessary record check. Currently there is 1 teen between the ages of 14 to 16 that is attending, with other teens over 16 attending as well. We appreciate their time to provide this program. Staff has also started back up Roller Time in the Arena on Fridays. We will provide more time during the summer months. We currently have 11 programs available: 3 for kids/teens, 5 for adults and 3 for everyone.

There were 9 room bookings with 3 re-occurring bookings. This included the Federal Election and a dance performance by the auTour Dance Company through the BC Movement Arts Society. The BCMA Society is wanting to bring more performances to Port Alice.

Easter crafts were provided on Saturday the 19th during the market. They were given a couple kits to make and take home. The kids enjoyed it.

On the 12th we provided space for an indoor Garage Sale. There were five people that participated in this. They appreciated the opportunity to sell their items indoors. There was also a market on the 19th, with 18 vendors in total. This is by far our largest Saturday Market so far. The markets are doing well and so far, have had to be in the gym.

With Canada Day approaching, I would like to see what council's thoughts are on prizes for the parade floats. We have previously awarded cash prizes for 1st, 2nd and 3rd. Do we want to continue with that or come up with another option? Also, as we are trying to incorporate the Village's 60th Anniversary into the day, do we want to have the Village logo on the cupcakes, the Canada Flag or both? Currently breakfast and lunch are being provided free of charge. Salmon and a \$300 store credit have been donated towards dinner. A cash donation for prizes for the kids fishing derby has also been donated.

The Village is celebrating its 60th Anniversary in the Rumble Beach location. We offered people a chance to design a graphic for a t-shirt. There are 7 people that entered, with 14 entries. One design needs to be chosen. Although we have promoted for a t-shirt, we could put the design on something else if necessary, such as a banner, flag, decals, etc.

A decision needs to be made on the Summer Hours, so we know for any summer room bookings. Last year we started the last two weeks of June, Tuesday to Saturday 10am – 6pm. Switching to seven days a week July and August. Then returning to our fall/winter hours the first week in September.

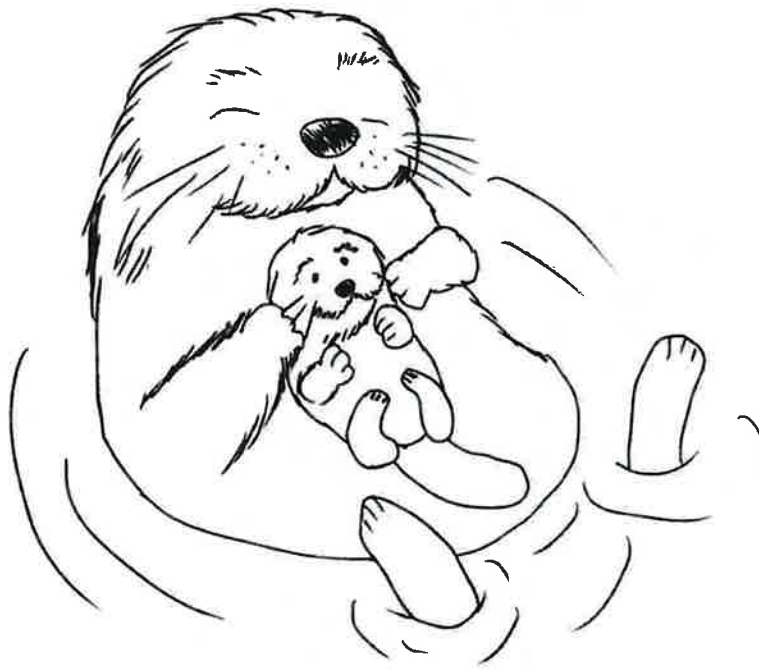
