October's Month End Report

Programs are doing well. Adult classes such as Tai Chi, Yoga and Belly Dance are doing great. The Belly Dance instructor, Sheila, has also donated her time to instruct the Kids Dance Club on Fridays. Sheila knows many forms of dance and is working with the kids to provide dance and music the kids want. Both her and the kids are really enjoying it. The paid Kids Crafts is going slow. Sometimes they just want to draw or burn energy in the gym. We play various games with them, like octopus, which they enjoy. Toddler Time has not been well attended, so we are cutting it down to one day a week. If attendance picks up, we can add the day back. Now that it is getting colder, we will cancel Roller Time for now, with the odd pop-up session when the weather is warmer.

We had six room bookings with three reoccurring bookings. The Village provided space for an Outreach Session by the CRA and Service Canada for the services they provide.

There were two model ships donated to the Village, the Smit Rotterdam and the Boston Typhoon. They are approximately 4 feet and 5 feet long. They are being displayed in a case at the Community Centre lobby.

Halloween Carnival was on Saturday October 25th from 12pm-4pm. There were bouncy castles, games and crafts for everyone to enjoy. Concession was provided by the Lions Club. The cost of the rental of bouncy castles was \$1837.50. At the time of writing this report, we have received \$1241 in donations, with another donation expected.

A decision needs to be made regarding our Christmas closure. We usually close for one week during the Christmas holidays. I propose December 23^{rd} to 27^{th} . Back open December 30^{th} and closed Thursday January 1^{st} .
