
While we have been given the option of continuing to advertise in the Rumble Sheet for a fee, there is a better option which will not add to Branch costs and still serve the community.

Our intent would be to only advertise events at the Branch. Information would be provided monthly on a fixed schedule so as not to place an inordinate amount of extra work on Community Center staff.

The digital marquee sign was purchased by the Village to communicate activities available to residents. It has the capacity to handle the information we propose to add, and I believe that a "Community" sign should be available to support the wider community in Port Alice.

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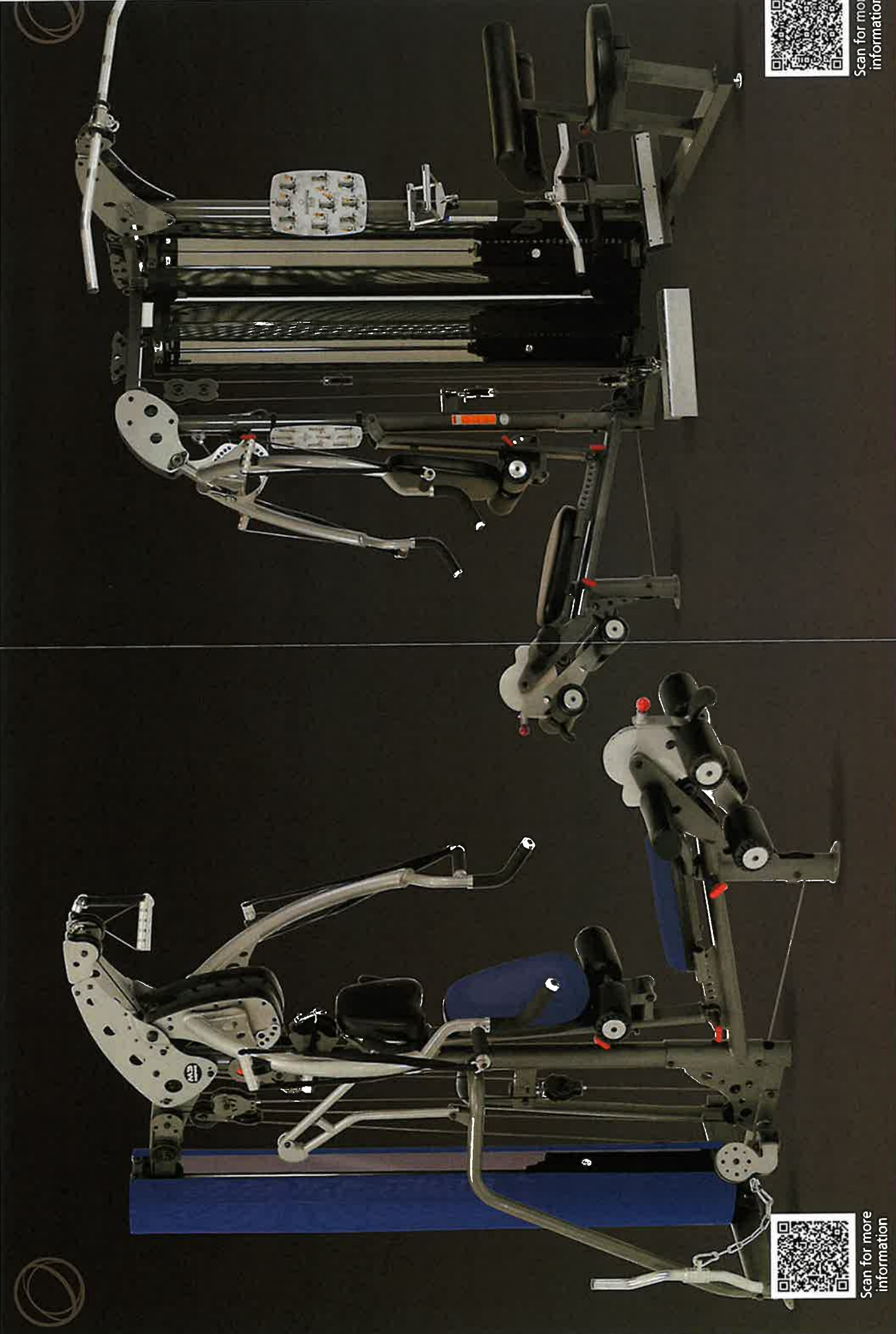

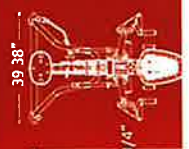
